Read: <u>Romans 12:1-2</u>, <u>1 Peter 2:9</u>

To live a life that is consecrated means that you have decided to live a life that is holy and dedicated to God. It means that you have chosen to live a life of sanctification understanding that you have been set apart for God and for His glory. To live your life for the Lord and in service to Him means that you have chosen to be holy as He is holy. Romans 12:1-2 encourages you to "...present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." Your "reasonable service" meaning your spiritual worship. Living a consecrated life also means that you know who you are and whose you are. 1 Peter 2:9 (ESV) says "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession...".
