January 24, 2021 "Ask, Seek, Knock"

Read: Matthew 7:7-12

Did you know that if you ask, seek, and knock, the Lord will respond? To ask means to "say something in order to obtain an answer or some information." To seek means to "attempt to find something or desire to obtain or achieve something." To knock means to "strike a surface noisily to attract attention, especially when waiting to be let in through a door."

All of these words are of great significance when you petition God because this is what the Word of God instructs you to do:

- •You are to "ask" God. Say something to Him because you desire answers and information.
- •You are to "seek" God. Is there something you desire to obtain or achieve? If you answered "yes", then you are to seek God in order to obtain or achieve.
- •Are there some doors in your life that you desire to be opened? If so, then your instruction is to "knock". Your willingness to "knock" sends out a sound that attracts the attention of God and causes doors to open that are meant to be opened just for you.
